





CAROLYN HARRISON CEO/FOUNDER

Carolyn Harrison is a proud Bronx resident. She is grateful for 10 years of being part of a community of resilient and resourceful people who resist being defined by narratives shaped by others. This way of being has informed Harrison's own creative

contributions to the Bronx artistic renaissance currently underway.

Harrison's formal training in Theater and Theology (BA '88, MA '05, and M.Div '15) was successfully parlayed into a 25-year teaching career. Her years of service as an Arts educator and administrator for private and public schools also included work for the John Houseman Acting Company under the direction of Margot Harley; development of new works for youth at the Carpetbag Theatre Company under the direction of Linda Parris-Bailey; and freelancing as a Stage Director and Teaching Artist for schools in Detroit, MI, Spokane, WA, and Knoxville, TN.

In 2018 Harrison formalized Good Light Productions, LLC (GLP) in order to create access and opportunities for underresourced and underrepresented creatives to tell their own stories. GLP is grateful for the financial support from local and state arts agency grant funding, as well as individual angel funders, patrons, and friends.
